Land Overnights: Anchorage 1, Denali 2, Sutton 1, Anchorage 1

- Aug 2 Arrive into Anchorage. Meet your Premier Alaska Tours Director and transfer to your hotel for overnight. Overnight Anchorage.
- Aug 3 This morning board your motorcoach as you travel north to **Denali National Park**. Enjoy a visit to the community of **Talkeetna**, the base camp for climbers of Mt. McKinley. Keep an eye out for views of Mt. McKinley. Continue to Denali. There is time for optional activities in Denali, such as rafting (mild to wild), flightseeing, jet boat safari, horse back riding, biking and much more. Overnight Denali. Meals:None
- Aug 4 This morning, travel deep into Denali National Park on the **Tundra Wildlife Tour** looking for bear, moose, caribou, and sheep. A snack box lunch is included. This afternoon, enjoy time at leisure to explore on your own or optional tour, such as rafting (mild to wild), flightseeing, jet boat safari and much more. This evening, enjoy a **cookout** at **Otto Lake** and enjoy this scenic area of Alaska. Overnight Denali Meals:SBM,D
- Aug 5 This morning, board your motorcoach as you travel along the *Denali Highway* and the Glenn/Richardson Highways to **Sheep Mountain Lodge**. You travel past Wrangell/St. Elias National Park (the largest national park in the United States). Overnight Sheep Mountain. Meals: D
- Aug 6 This morning make sure you have boots that cover your ankles. You will walk on the **Matanuska Glacier** on the guided **Ice Fall Trek**, where you learn about glaciers, moraines, moulins and much more. Afterwards, travel via motorcoach to Anchorage for a brief **city tour** and time on own. Tonight enjoy dinner at the **Sourdough Mining Company** and enjoy a visit to the Wildberry Park area, where you view the largest chocolate waterfall in North America. Overnight Anchorage. Meals:B,L,SDM
- Aug 7 This morning, transfer to the rail depot for a ride on the world famous **Alaska Railroad** for your scenic journey south to the coastal community of Seward. While in Seward, there are many options to choose from in this coastal community. You may wish to visit the Alaska Sealife Center, the only cold water research facility in North America, kayak or sail in Resurrection Bay, ride in a sled pulled by champion Iditarod sled dogs at Iditaride, visit the Seward Museum or Exit Glacier and more. This afternoon, transfer to the Radiance of the Seas. Depart 9pm. Cruise only guests would arrive today and board the ship
- Aug 8 **Cruise Hubbard Glacier** -The longest river of ice in North America, the Hubbard Glacier is also one of the most active glaciers of its kind in Alaska. And since our ships are designed to

provide our guests with the best viewing possible, you'll be able to see this massive natural wonder, with its 1,350 square miles of blue ice, from just about anywhere on the ship.

- Aug 9 Visit **Juneau, Alaska**. Arrive 8:00am and depart 9:00pm. Juneau, the capital of Alaska, was founded during a gold rush in 1880. Today, the former gold-mining town counts among its riches some of Alaska's most spectacular scenery. Nestled at the foot of Mt. Juneau in the Alaska Panhandle, it faces the water from the mainland side of Gastineau Channel. Several magnificent fjords are located along the channel coast, and the majestic Mendenhall Glacier, a favorite of visitors, is nearby.
- Aug 10 Visit **Skagway, Alaska**. Arrive 7:00am and depart 8:30pm. When gold was discovered in the Klondike region of the Yukon Territory (just across the border from Alaska), it resulted in the historic Gold Rush of 1898. As thousands of gold-crazed adventurers sought the best starting point for their arduous trek, they found the deepest penetration possible by boat was at the northern tip of the Lynn Canal. This is how Skagway was born.
- Aug 11 Visit **Icy Strait Point, Alaska**. Arrive 7:00am and depart 4:00pm. Icy Strait Point is located near the city of Hoonah, the largest native Tlingit Indian settlement in Alaska, and very near Glacier Bay National Park. Home to a historic cannery, the port's connection to the sea is strong. Locals share the sea with humpback whales, orcas, Dall porpoises, seals, sea otters, halibut and all five species of Pacific salmon. It is not uncommon to spot a humpback or an orca while walking along the shore.
- Aug 12 Visit **Ketchikan, Alaska**. Arrive 9:00am and depart 6:00pm. Ketchikan originated as an Indian fish saltery, but the town's major growth began when it became a supply base and entry port for miners during the 1898 Gold Rush to the Klondike. Much of the town's colorful past is still in evidence, especially in the nearby Indian villages, where you'll see colorfully carved totem poles and hear the fascinating legends that surround them.
- Aug 13 Cruise the **Inside Passage** - Cruising through the Inside Passage is really what has made Alaska cruising so popular. This trip captures so much of what people love about Alaska. There are glaciers the size of Rhode Island. Misty rain forests and ghostly blue fjords. And spirited communities that celebrate their varied heritage. Be sure to take in every view as you sail through one of the most beautiful parts of Alaska.
- Aug 14 Disembark in Vancouver, British Columbia. Transfer to airport for flight home.
